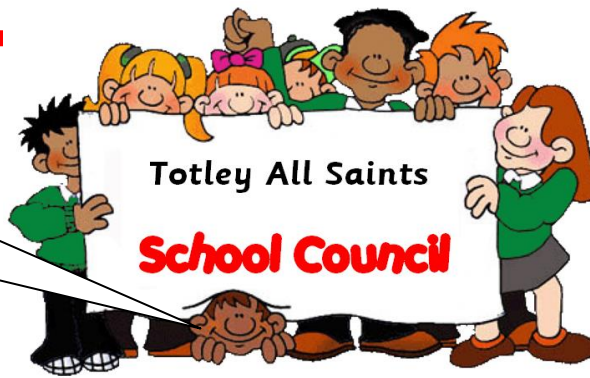

### Roles & Responsibilities:

The roles are as follows:

- ☺ Chair Person – leads the meetings and helps set the agenda through gaining feedback from the other representatives on issues that have been raised by their year group.
- ☺ Vice Chair Person – assists the Chair Person and ensures that all of the representatives carry out their roles effectively. They will also run the meeting in the absence of the Chair Person.
- ☺ Secretary – takes the minutes of each meeting which are distributed to all of the classes.
- ☺ Treasurer – Works alongside the other representatives in managing the budget.
- ☺ Publicity Representatives – ensure that information from the School Council is made known & publicises any events. They also make sure that the website page is up to date and that the ABC Book (Actions, Benefit, Celebration) is kept up to date with achievements.
- ☺ Class Representatives - All School Council members are their class representatives and make sure that information is passed both to and from the School Council meetings.
