# Parent End of Year Questionnaire

## FEEDBACK 2012-13

Out of a potential 199 pupils, 63 parents took part in the questionnaire (it is unknown how many families are represented). All figures were rounded for ease of understanding.

### Wellbeing & Safety

#### (1) My child is happy at this school:

98% of parents felt that their children were happy with just one parent disagreeing (where responses were negative, this parent's response was negative on most instances). 97% of pupils across the school said that they were happy at the school with few exceptions

#### (2) My child feels safe at this school

98% of parents felt that their children were safe with one parent saying that they didn't know. No responses were negative. 99% of pupils overall said that they felt safe

#### (4) My child is well looked after at this school

98% of parents felt that their children were well looked after with just one parent in disagreement.

### Teaching & Learning

#### (3) My child makes good progress at this school

97% of parents felt that their children made good progress with 2 parents disagreeing.

#### (5) My child is taught well at this school

94% of parents felt that their children were well taught with 2 parents saying that they didn't know & 2 saying that they disagreed.

#### (6) My child receives appropriate homework for their age

76% of parents responded positively to the issue of appropriate homework (very similar to the children's views at 78%), 10% didn't know if this was the case & 14% responded negatively. The school knew that Homework was an issue already & undertook a detailed questionnaire to gauge views in the summer term. The findings were by no means conclusive but seemed to show that **homework should be more carefully considered by teachers & include some differentiation according to ability, have an opt in or out of home learning projects & be based around Reading, Spellings & Maths activities.**

### Behaviour

#### (7) This school makes sure that its pupils are well behaved

94% of parents felt that pupils are well behaved, 4% didn't know & no parents responded negatively to this comment. 83% across the school felt that children behaved well in their class, but were not asked about behaviour beyond their own classroom. **In order to**

**maintain consistency & excellent behaviour, teachers will need to ensure that the Establishment Phase is used to focus on the very highest standards of behaviour & that these are insisted upon on a daily basis using the positive reward system. Additionally, anyone covering PPA must use the same systems in order to ensure consistency.**

**(8) This school deals effectively with bullying**

48% of parents felt that bullying is dealt with effectively with almost the same number (46%) saying that they didn't know (suggesting that they may have not encountered bullying as an issue and/or do not know how it is dealt with). 4 parents responded negatively to this comment & were obviously referring to very specific instances that they felt were bullying. In terms of pupil responses, 92% of pupils felt that other children were friendly in school & 37% of pupils felt that they had been bullied. **This would suggest a new response & back to basics approach to Bullying is needed & that this needs to be well communicated to children & parents alike.**

**Leadership & Management**

**(9) This school is well led & managed**

97% of parents felt that this was the case, one parent didn't know & just one responded negatively.

**(10) This school responds well to any concerns I raise**

87% of parents felt that concerns were well responded to & 10% didn't know (suggesting that they hadn't had concerns that needed to be responded to. Just 2 parents felt that concerns were not well responded to.

**(11) I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress**

90% of parents felt that they received valuable information on progress, 2% didn't know & 8% did not.

**Other**

**(12) Would you recommend this school to another parent?**

94% of parents said that they would recommend, 3 didn't know & one disagreed strongly.
