Out of a potential 199 pupils, 185 took part in the questionnaire. The response was lowest in Y5 (19 out of 28 pupils).

## **Wellbeing & Safety**

### **(1) I am happy at this school.**

97% of pupils across the school said that they were happy at the school with few exceptions. All classes scored very high in this element.

### **(2) I feel safe at this school.**

99% of pupils overall said that they felt safe.

## **Teaching & Learning**

### **(5) I like my teacher.**

99% of pupils felt that they liked their teacher & teachers scored a high rating in every year group.

### **(6) My teacher is kind & fair.**

98% of pupils felt that their teacher is kind & fair with all teachers scoring similarly high results.

### **(7) My teacher helps me when I don't know what to do.**

9% of pupils felt that teachers helped when they didn't know what to do with all scoring similarly high results.

### **(8) My teacher helps me if I have a problem or am worried.**

99% of pupils felt that their teacher helped them if they had a problem or were worried with all scoring similarly high results.

### **(9) My teacher makes lessons fun.**

96% of pupils felt that their teacher made lessons fun, although less lessons were regarded so in Y6. From the comments it is clear that this is not as simple as thinking that the lessons were less fun due to SATs revision & that lessons covered as part of PPA were not always enjoyed.

### **(10) I learn a lot in class.**

96% of pupils felt that they learned a lot in class.

### **(11) The work in class is just right – not too hard or too easy.**

89% of pupils said that the work that they were given was just right although this was less so in Y2ES (82%), Y1SF(85%) & Y5WB (84%). From the comments, some children felt that some work was too easy & could be harder. **This will require teachers to further carefully consider how well tasks are matched to children on an ongoing basis & to have fluid groups in terms of differentiation. A revisiting of this question as part of a learning conference will also be**

**beneficial to discuss the issues involved as well as make children understand if the work really is too easy or not.**

**(12)I get the right amount of homework.**

78% of pupils felt that they got the right amount of homework proving that this can be one of the most contentious issues for us as a school. Those year groups that felt that this was less the case were: Y4 RK/HD (43%), Y2ES (64%) & Y5WB(68%). Our questionnaire to parents last term, was by no means conclusive but seemed to show that **homework should be more carefully considered by teachers & include some differentiation according to ability, have an opt in or out of home learning project & be based around Reading, Spellings & Maths activities.**

## **Behaviour**

**(4)I think that other children are friendly in school.**

92% of pupils felt that other children were friendly in school. Percentages were highest in FS2JS/LW (100%), Y3LH/RK (96%), Y4RK/HD & Y6IM (93%).

**(3)I think children behave well in my class.**

83% across the school felt that children behaved well in their class.

The lowest percentages that felt that this was the case were in Y6IM (56%), Y3LH/RK (74%), Y1SF (79%) & Y2ES (82%). The highest percentages that felt that children behaved well in their classes was Y4RK/HD (100%) FS2JS/LW (96%) & Y5WB (95%). **In order to maintain consistency & excellent behaviour, teachers will need to ensure that the Establishment Phase is used to focus on the very highest standards of behaviour & that these are insisted upon on a daily basis using the positive reward system. Additionally, anyone covering PPA must use the same systems in order to ensure consistency.**

**(13)I have been bullied in this school.**

37% of pupils felt that they had been bullied whilst 63% felt that they hadn't. This figure appears quite consistent in all year groups apart from FS2 which was much lower according to the teachers due to a lack of understanding in this matter. Either this is the case that bullying is prevalent or a better understanding of what bullying is needs to be addressed. Judging by the Parent Questionnaire response to this question as well as the very few accusations of bullying which are reported (& which under further investigation are found to be merely fallouts), **a new response & back to basics approach to Bullying is called for.**

**(14)I know what to do if I am bullied.**

94% of pupils now what to do if they are bullied. This can however, be improved upon in order that all pupils know what to do as explained in question 13.
