Out of a potential 209 pupils, 198 took part in the questionnaire in the last three weeks of school.

## **Wellbeing & Safety**

### **(1) I am happy at this school.**

96% of pupils across the school said that they were happy at the school with few exceptions (up from 92% the previous year). All classes scored very high in this element, particularly FS2, Y1 & Y3 at 100%.

### **(2) I feel safe at this school.**

92% of pupils overall said that they felt safe (93% last year). All classes scored high apart from Y4 (72%) & Y2 (83%).

## **Teaching & Learning**

### **(5) I like my teacher.**

As last year, 98% of pupils felt that they liked their teacher & teachers scored a high rating in every year group.

### **(6) My teacher is kind & fair.**

96% (previously 97%) of pupils felt that their teacher is kind & fair with all teachers scoring similarly high results.

### **(7) My teacher helps me when I don't know what to do.**

As last year, 95% of pupils felt that teachers helped when they didn't know what to do with all scoring similarly high results.

### **(8) My teacher helps me if I have a problem or am worried.**

95% (previously 97%) of pupils felt that their teacher helped them if they had a problem or were worried with all scoring similarly high results.

### **(9) My teacher makes lessons fun.**

92% (previously 93%) of pupils felt that their teacher made lessons fun.

### **(10) I learn a lot in class.**

92% (previously 93%) of pupils felt that they learned a lot in class.

### **11) The work in class is just right – not too hard or too easy.**

82% (previously 83%) of pupils said that the work that they were given was just right. From the comments, some children felt that some work was too easy & could be harder. This is sometimes the over optimistic views of a child regarding their own abilities – which is of course what we want to foster. However, **teachers will need continue to consider how well tasks are matched to children on an ongoing basis & to have fluid groups in terms of differentiation. A revisiting of this question as part of a learning conference will also be beneficial to discuss the issues involved as well as make children understand if the work really is too easy or not.**

**(12)I get the right amount of homework.**

79% (previously 84%) of pupils felt that they got the right amount of homework. This comes on the back of the homework policy introduced in September 2013 (as a result of the findings of the Parent & Pupil Questionnaires held two years ago). However, judging by the comments that were written by the children, it would be difficult for this to be a positive outcome as some preferred to have no homework at all!

**Behaviour**

**(4)I think that other children are friendly in school.**

91% of pupils (previously 92%) felt that other children were friendly in school.

**(3)I think children behave well in my class.**

86% of pupils (previously 72%) across the school felt that children behaved well in their class which is an improvement on last year.

**(13)I have been bullied in this school.**

14% of pupils felt that they had been bullied (down by 15% on last year's 29%) whilst 85% felt that they hadn't (71% last year). This is also an improvement on 2012-13's figures of 37% & 63%. Any case of bullying is of course disappointing, particularly because of our substantial work on Anti-Bullying & the No Touch Rule (started in October 2013 as a result of that year's questionnaire). It is important to note that this figure is not backed up by reports of bullying as only 6 allegations were made & only half of these were found to be cases of actual bullying (unkind words, intimidation & one physical act). Generally, where children believe that bullying has taken place, this is often found to be a falling out where both parties are at fault. **As ever, we shall endeavour to keep up the momentum of this important issue into the new academic year.**

**(14)I know what to do if I am bullied.**

As a result of our launch of our Anti-Bullying policy & No Touch Rule, the number of children who know what to do if they are bullied has remained constant at 94%.
