

Play in Dore Breakfast Club

We now have an additional service to Play in Dore After school club, we now provide a Breakfast club as well. Due to the amount of parents requesting us for Breakfast club care, we have decided to open one up to accommodate.

The Breakfast club will open Earlier than existing Breakfast clubs and starts at 6:45 - School start time, from Monday-Friday (term time). Within this time the children will be provided with a variety of Healthy Breakfast choices and a chance to play or relax before the 'walking bus'.

We will provide a wide range of activities ranging from

- Structured educational based games
- Arts & Crafts
- Board Games
- Construction
- Messy play
- Reading
- Homework help

It will be based on the same play principals as Play in Dore After school club, and children will have the freedom of choice.

Play in Dore

Play in Dore provides healthy, nutritious and balanced food/drinks. Food and drink are safely prepared with regard to the dietary and religious requirements of the children in our care. We ask parents to notify us regarding any special dietary requirements or allergies when they register their child.

Information regarding food allergies is recorded on the Allergy Information Board which is visible to staff whilst food is being prepared.

Walking Bus

How do we get from Dore Primary School to the Play in Dore /Totley venue?
Simple - a 15 minute walking bus.

- It helps children achieve the recommended 60 minutes of physical activity a day.
- Promote safety awareness of roads and environmental hazards.
- It promoted a safe, non-polluting and sustainable transport alternative to cars and buses
- It helps foster a sense of community as families get to know each other, and their children become friends.
- Encourage physical activity by teaching children the skills to walk safely, how to identify safe routes to school, and the benefits of walking
- A risk assessment has been put in place to ensure the safety of the children. All factors have been considered and accounted.
- A reflective safety jacket is provided for all children and where necessary a waterproof poncho

Prices

Fees are charged per session and there are two options available:

- 6:45-School start time - £7.50 per session
- Existing customers of Play in Dore After school club will have a reduced rate of £6.50
- Flexible Ad hoc sessions available also.

This is **payable in advance** by cash or cheque, bank transfer or childcare vouchers. Cheques should be made payable to "Play in Dore Ltd".

The price per session per child applies to all children. Days off will be charged at a 50% discount providing that 1 months notice is given. In the event of child sickness, severe weather conditions, school closure or failure to provide 1 months notice, your full normal rate will still be charged.

We do not charge for bank holidays and professional training days. Please ensure that fees are paid promptly. Non-payment for more than one month may result in your place being terminated. If you are having difficulty paying fees, please speak in confidence to the Manager
