Aims

At Totley All Saints, we aim to ensure that all pupils:

- are equipped with essential skills for an online life.
- will learn how to stay safe and healthy, build and maintain successful relationships and become active citizens, responsibly participating in society online
- to identify possible online risks and make informed decisions about how to act
- to understand safe ways in which to seek support if they are concerned or upset by something they have seen online
- to understand what acceptable and unacceptable online behaviour look like
- to evaluate what they see online
- to recognise the techniques that are often used to persuade or manipulate others
- will develop their identity and self-esteem as active, confident members of their online community.
